

THE SUTTON FAIR & HORSE SHOW JUNIOR AMBASSADOR PROGRAM

is an event for students in grades 6-8. This exciting program provides the contestants with the opportunity to enhance their public speaking skills, work with the public and meet people in their community. The Junior Ambassador can participate in activities such as the Terry Fox Run, the Teddy Bear Picnic and the "Turkey's and Toys" Gala fundraiser. Components of the Junior Ambassador Program include a get-together prior to the Friday night competition, a group photo session, a meeting with the judges and speech on a predetermined subject (Yes, cue cards can be used!).

The winner of the Junior Ambassador Program must be committed to participate in activities held on the Saturday and Sunday of the Sutton Fair. He or she must provide their own transportation to the Fair and other events throughout the year. Consent of a parent/guardian is required and their signature must appear on the Entry Form. Entries without a parent/guardian signature will be disqualified. Deadline for entries is July 5th and there is a maximum of fifteen contestants.

There is no fee for this program. Contestants and their parent/guardian will receive free admission into the Sutton Fair on Friday night! Prizes will also be awarded to all contestants!
